Multiple Products found indicates the Product exists in multiple Departments in the currently logged in Location. Nothing is shown if the same Product exists in other Locations. The current Location is the default, but double-clicking on the Product Name opens the *Select Product from Attribute* window, providing the ability to see and select other Locations' Products.
