

Default Grade Factor Values

Default Grade Factor values can be set up to default as the Grade Factor result when adding Scale Tickets in the Grain module and when adding Scale Tickets in Grain Scale Interface (including during the import process if the Commodity is changed).

In the Grain module, go to *Setup / Commodities*. Edit a Commodity and, for every Grade Factor set up for this Commodity, enter *Default Value* that should be automatically populated when adding a Scale Ticket.

Note: These default values can be overwritten when adding a Scale Ticket.
