Uncheck Automatically Detect Settings with a Logon Script Using Group Policy Editor

In some cases, if the Internet LAN Settings are configured to automatically detect proxy settings, the Agvance modules may take an extra 10 or 15 seconds to open.

This setting can be turned off (unchecked) by setting up a logon script in Group Policy Editor.

1. Select **Start**. Type *gpedit.msc* in the *Search* field and press **Enter**.

Expand User Configuration and select Windows Settings.

2. Right-click **Notepad** and choose Run as administrator.
