Additionally, SSI also supports non-UGMA testers, including the Dickey-John GAC 2100 and the Steinlite SL95 Moisture Tester. All four units are GIPSA (Grain Inspections, Packers and Stockyards Administration) and NTEP (National Type Evaluation Program) approved.

The addition of the Perten tester is the first time GIPSA has approved more than a single moisture meter for use within the official inspection system. "Permitting multiple manufacturers to design moisture meters using the UGMA technology to improve the accuracy and repeatability of grain moisture meter testing allows for competition within the instrument marketplace for the benefit of moisture meter users," a representative of GIPSA said.
