

Tableau OAuth2 Setup

When using Sharepoint, OneDrive, Azure Data Lake, or Azure SQL Server, as a Tableau datasource, Microsoft is now requiring OAuth2 to be configured. Customers will be required to manage these Azure applications themselves and provide Client ID/Secrets to the SSI Tableau team.

In the coming months, the Azure Portal will only host Enterprise Applications while [Microsoft Entra](#) will have both Enterprise Applications and App Registrations. If your Tenant has been updated already, please use Microsoft Entra instead.
